

Energy policy

With this energy policy, Konzelmann GmbH undertakes to sustainably and continuously reduce relevant energy consumption throughout the company including the associated CO₂ emissions in compliance with the legally prescribed requirements. This is implemented on the basis of energy targets set annually by top management. The foundation for the target definition is the consumption and production data from the past, taking into account the cost-effectiveness of the measure.

The realisation of the energy policy takes place through the implementation of a complete energy management system according to Annex 2 SpaEfV for an SME in which:

- energy consumption is measured and monitored at regular intervals.
- key energy aspects are regularly recorded, reviewed and communicated.
- energy flows are recorded and kept up to date.
- processes and activities are permanently reviewed, evaluated and continuously improved in terms of their energy efficiency.
- energy saving measures are planned and introduced.
- the results of the energy-saving measures are recorded, analysed and evaluated at regular intervals.
- management provides necessary resources and information to achieve the energy targets.

The cooperation of all employees is necessary for the implementation of the energy policy. Employees are kept fully informed and involved in the action plan. The company's energy policy applies equally to all areas, activities and processes in the company to ensure the continuous improvement of energy performance.
